Parking and Road Safety

There have been several incidents over the past few weeks involving near misses and bumps on the road outside school, and I am sorry to say, an actual collision between two vehicles – thankfully no-one was hurt. As parental concern justifiably increases, one of our Governors is seeking to coordinate new action with the Parish Council and Local Authority to address issues with traffic calming measures, adjusted speed limits and parking capacity. This action, however, has to come from the parent body. The school has been told on many occasions in the past that until there is a serious incident or fatality, as a result of traffic congestion at the school, there will be nothing done to alleviate the difficulties you all face twice a day. First thing's first... Parents <u>do not</u> need to sign up or continually help at every event. Parents can give as much or as little time as they want and together we will continue to try and mitigate the current economic challenges facing schools and communities in general. Brockhampton's PTA has a great track record in raising money and securing funding from local business and charities. All this money goes straight into school to ensure we can continue to deliver the primary experience the children both deserve and are entitled to. Without it, the school would simply be unable to maintain its current offer and provision. Recently, PTA funding enabled the fencing at the front of the school to be replaced and re-built so that now it meets the minimum required safety heights. Money has also been invested on all new playground equipment for all three playgrounds (you may have seen some of it gracing the roof, road and gutters!!) complete with storage, so that the children have resources to play with during their breaks. The PTA are also investing money into resources to support the teaching of the curriculum; boxes of bespoke science, music and art equipment for example, without which the children would not have the necessary resources that enrich the curriculum delivery.
